

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Volunteers covered by Policy

The travel insurance covers the following categories of UK resident volunteers:

- Council, Board, Forum, Committee, Expert Panels or Working Party Members
- Branch and Specialist Group Committee Members
- Professional Review Assessors
- Examiners, Invigilators and Education Assessors

The policy is held in the name of The British Computer Society, whose business name is BCS, The Chartered Institute for IT (the Insured) and the application of any funds is at the discretion of the BCS Trustees.

Details of Policy

Overseas Cover:

Any trip in connection with the sole business of the Insured involving any travel outside the United Kingdom and shall start from the time of leaving home or place of business (whichever is left last) and continue until arrival back home or normal place of business (whichever is reached first).

To clarify, any trip that involves business other than that of the Insured will not be covered.

Personal Accident (death & capital benefits)	Maximum limit of £50,000 per capita
Medical Expenses	£10,000,000
Baggage & Personal Effects	£2,500
Money	£1,500
Cancellation	£5,000

To obtain cover for overseas travel, you must notify Ann Southgate at BCS HQ in advance; cover will only be confirmed once full details of the trip have been provided.

UK Travel:

Whilst an Insured Person is engaged in connection with the business of the Insured within the United Kingdom.

Cover limited to Personal Accident only **Maximum limit of £50,000 per capita**

Any property belonging to the Insured is covered as part of the Combined Insurance Policy.
